# DECISION 2014/018/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY

### of 24 April 2014

# adopting Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Part-SPO of Regulation (EU) No 965/2012

#### 'AMC and GM to Part-SPO'

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No  $216/2008^1$ , and in particular Article 38(3)(a),

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No  $965/2012^2$  and in particular ARO.GEN.120 of Annex II (Part-ARO) thereof,

#### Whereas:

(1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18(c) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, issue Certification Specifications and Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.

- (2) Acceptable Means of Compliance are non-binding standards adopted by the Agency which illustrate the means to establish compliance with Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.
- (3) Guidance material is non-binding material developed by the Agency which helps to illustrate the meaning of a requirement or specification and is used to support the interpretation of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, its Implementing Rules, Certification Specifications and Acceptable Means of Compliance.

Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC (OJ L 79, 19.3.2008, p. 1, as last amended by Commission Regulation (EU) No of 8 January 2013 (OJ L 4, 9.1.2013, p. 34).

Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 of the European Commission of 5 October 2012 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to air operations pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council (OJ, L 296, 25.10.2012, p.1), as last amended by Commission Regulation (EU) No 379/2014, OJ L 123, 24.4.2014, p. 1

- (4) The Agency shall, pursuant to the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence of Article 19(2) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008, reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the fields concerned.
- (5) This Decision provides air operators with means to comply with the technical requirements for specialised operations and further guidance with the objective to maintain a high level of safety and to ensure proportionate application of this Regulation, where appropriate, and to warrant flexibility and efficiency for operators and authorities.
- (6) The Agency, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and Articles 5(3) and 6 and 7 of the Agency's Rulemaking Procedure<sup>3</sup>, has widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received<sup>4</sup>.

HAS DECIDED:

#### Article 1

The Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to Annex VIII (Part-SPO) to Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 are those laid down in the Annex to this Decision.

### Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2014.
