DECISION N° 2006/08/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY

of 11 October 2006

on the adoption of the amended 2007 Rulemaking Programme

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to the decision of the Management Board concerning the procedure to be applied by the Agency for the issuing of opinions, certification specifications and guidance material ("rulemaking procedure") adopted on 27 June 2003, which requires, inter alia, the Executive Director to establish an annual rulemaking programme in consultation with the Safety Standards Consultative Committee and the Advisory Group of National Authorities;

In accordance with article 3.6 of the said rulemaking procedure, the Agency amends the 2007 Rulemaking Programme in view of an unforeseen and urgent demand;

HAS DECIDED:

Article 1

To include the task MDM.041 "Continued operation of CIS States of design aircraft registered by Member States" and to adopt the attached amended 2007 Rulemaking Programme.

Article 2 Entry into force

This Decision shall enter into force on 11 October 2006. It shall be published in the Official Publication of the Agency. Decision 2006/07/R of the Executive Director of the Agency, of 31 July 2006, on the adoption of the 2007 Rulemaking Programme is hereby repealed.
