DECISION 2013/012/R OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY

OF 12TH JULY 2013

Adopting amendment 8 of Decision No 2003/10/RM of the Executive Director of the Agency of 24 October 2003 on Certification Specifications, including Airworthiness Codes and Acceptable Means of Compliance, for European Technical Standard Orders (CS-ETSO)

'Systematic review and transposition of existing FAA TSO standards for parts and appliances into EASA ETSO'

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency, and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC¹ (hereinafter referred to as the 'Basic Regulation'), and in particular Articles 18(c), 38(3)(a) and (e) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 748/2012 of 03 August 2012 laying down implementing rules for the airworthiness and environmental certification of aircraft and related products, parts and appliances, as well as for the certification of design and production organisations², in particular 21A.16A of the Annex (Part-21) thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) The Executive Director issued Certification Specifications including Airworthiness Code and Acceptable Means of Compliance, for European Technical Standard Orders (CS-ETSO) in the Annex to Executive Director Decision No 2003/10/RM of 24 October 2003 (Initial Issue)³.
- (2) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue Certification Specifications, including Airworthiness Codes and Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as guidance material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its implementing rules.

- (3) The Agency is obliged, pursuant to Article 19 of the Basic Regulation to reflect the state of the art and the best practices in the fields concerned and update Certification Specifications taking into account world wide aircraft experience in service, and scientific and technical progress.
- (4) The Agency has determined a need to improve the Certification Specifications with respect to equipment approval either by updating the existing, or introducing new ETSOs to account for changes in technology and industry expectations.
- (5) The Agency has, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation and Articles 5.3 and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure⁴, widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received⁵,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Annex to the Executive Director Decision No 2003/10/RM of 24 October 2003 containing the Certification Specifications applicable to European Technical Standard Orders (CS-ETSO) is hereby amended in accordance with the Annexes to this Decision.

Article 2

1. This Decision shall enter into force on the day of publication in the official publication of the Agency
2. By way of derogation from 1, this Decision shall not apply to applications received until 31 December 2013, if so requested by the applicant and providing that in such a case the applicant can demonstrate that the process of development of the relevant part or appliance started before the entry into force of this Decision, in accordance with the specifications applicable at that time.
