1.Subject: THERMAL/ACOUSTIC INSULATION BLANKETS
2.Problem / Statement of issue and justification; reason for regulatory evolution (regulatory tasks): FAA has issued NPRM 00-09 Improved Flammability Standards for Thermal/Acoustic Insulation Materials Used in Transport Category Airplanes on September 20, 2000 adopted as amendment 25.111 on 31 July 2003. The JAA has performed a review of this proposal and has developed a draft NPA 25D-345.
3.Objective: The aim is to improve the flammability standards for thermal/acoustic Insulation Materials.
4. Specific tasks and interface issues (Deliverables): To consider the draft NPA 25D-345 and deliver a draft EASA NPA to amend CS-25, accompanied with proper justification (Explanatory Note).
5. Working Methods (in addition to the applicable EASA procedures): The initial meeting should be held early enough so as to allow to meet the task within the required timescale; Meetings shall be held at the Agency's head office or at the Central JAA depending where the Agency support to the group is provided.
6. Time scale, milestones: The draft EASA NPA should be delivered before 31 October 2004 .
