Reference documents: Package of draft Certification Specifications for Airships and Balloons as produced under the responsibility of Core Group 9.

1.Subject: Certification Specifications for Airships and Balloons

2.Problem / Statement of issue and justification; reason for regulatory evolution (regulatory tasks):

Because the airworthiness of balloons and airships is within the competence of the Agency, there is a need to establish Certification Specifications for these types of aircraft.

3.Objective:

To develop NPA's for Certification Specifications for public consultation for the the six different categories of balloons and airships.

4. Specific tasks and interface issues (Deliverables):

The ad-hoc sub-group of Core group 9, which was tasked to transpose all airworthiness JARs into Certification Specifications, produced draft CS for balloons and airships based on various national codes but also on joint work of several authorities. This material should be reviewed for consistency with the transposition policy for other CS and compatibility with EASA and EU rules in general with the aim to produce NPAs which are mature enough for public consultation.

5. Working Methods: (in addition to the applicable EASA procedures)

Drafting carried out by Rulemaking Directorate.

6. Time scale, milestones:

The draft EASA NPAs should be delivered **before 31 October 2004.**
