Question:

I have a degree from a country that is not a Member State of the European Union nor an EASA Member State. Am I eligible for a vacancy advertised by the Agency?

Answer:

If your application is found eligible on the basis of diploma(s) obtained outside these countries, we might ask you to provide proof of accreditation by one of the European Union Member States. This applies also to diplomas obtained in the UK after 31 December 2020. Failure to provide such accreditation will result in your application being disqualified from the selection procedure.
