New aircraft will be registered in the Netherlands during 2021. The opt?in for Part I and II will enter into force on 1 July 2021. Part I will only be applicable to aircraft and helicopters that will be newly registered in the Netherlands for the Coastguard and for SAR purposes. Part III will enter into force for SAR helicopter operations on 1 July 2021. Since some more preparation time is needed for the Coastguard fixed wing operations, Part III will enter into force on 1 March 2022 for these operations.
