

1. when to Evacuate

a) Following acoustic signal

b) Following instructions by emergency team

2. Evacuation signal and route

Signal: Continuous siren and/or voice message over loudspeaker Routes: Nearest fire exit

3. Evacuation procedure

- a) Warn other people, help handicapped or injured persons
- b) Only use stairs and marked escape routes
- c) Do not use lifts
- d) Do not return to collect personal belongings
- e) Go directly to the assembly point
- f) Do not return to the building until instructed to do so


