**DECISION N° 2012/011/DIRECTORATE R
OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY**

of 26th June 2012

**ON THE CERTIFICATION SPECIFICATIONS FOR HELICOPTER FLIGHT SIMULATION
TRAINING DEVICES**

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February 2008 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency ('the Agency'), and repealing Council Directive 91/670/EEC, Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 and Directive 2004/36/EC¹ (hereinafter the 'Basic Regulation'), and in particular Article 4(2), Article 7 and Annex III thereof, and

having regard to Commission Regulation (EU) No 290/2012 of 30 March 2012 amending Commission Regulation (EU) No 1178/2011 of 3 November 2011 on technical requirements and administrative procedures related to civil aviation aircrew pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and in particular Annex VI 'Authority Requirements Aircrew (Part-ARA)' and Annex VII 'Organisation Requirements Aircrew (Part-ORA)' thereof.

WHEREAS:

- (1) The Agency shall, pursuant to Article 18 of the Basic Regulation, issue Acceptable Means of Compliance, as well as Guidance Material for the application of the Basic Regulation and its Implementing Rules.
- (2) The Agency has, pursuant to Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation and Articles 5(3) and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure², widely consulted interested parties on the matters which are the subject of this Decision and has provided thereafter a written response to the comments received³.
