1. Subject: Approval of Navigation Database Providers

2. Problem / Statement of issue and justification; reason for regulatory evolution (regulatory tasks):

Improved control of data held in aircraft navigational databases is necessary to support the implementation of RNAV and RNP concepts. Operational approval for these concepts relies heavily on the approval of navigation database suppliers.

3. Objective:

To develop Guidance Material for the approval of Navigation Database providers under Subpart G of Part 21, if this is deemed to be appropriate and consistent with the concept of POA.

4. Specific tasks and interface issues (Deliverables):

Agency: Draft the EASA NPA based upon the draft JAA TGM. The explanatory note should explain and highlight the legal difficulties with the concept of POA for Navigation Database suppliers.

Group: Draft the Comment Response Document and final text based on the NPA and the comments received. Special note should be taken of the above legal issue.

Interface with Eurocontrol is necessary.

5. Working Methods: (in addition to the applicable EASA procedures):

The initial meeting should be held early enough so as to allow to meet the task within the required timescale;

Meetings shall be held at the Agency's head office or at the Central JAA depending where the Agency support to the group is provided.

6. Time scale, milestones:

The draft EASA NPA should be delivered **before 26 May 2004**

The draft EASA Comment Response document and draft final text should be delivered **before 27 November 2004**
