of 13 December 2023

ADOPTING THE EUROPEAN PLAN FOR AVIATION SAFETY (EPAS) VOLUMES II 'ACTIONS' AND III 'SAFETY RISK PORTFOLIOS' 2024 EDITIONS

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to the REGULATION (EU) 2018/1139¹ OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 4 July 2018 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Union Aviation Safety Agency, and amending Regulations (EC) No 2111/2005, (EC) No 1008/2008, (EU) No 996/2010, (EU) No 376/2014 and Directives 2014/30/EU and 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council, and repealing Regulations (EC) No 552/2004 and (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Regulation (EEC) No 3922/91; and in particular Article 98 (2)(u) thereof;

Whereas EASA shall in accordance with Article 6 (1) of REGULATION (EU) 2018/1139 in collaboration with Member States and relevant stakeholders develop, and subsequently update at least on a yearly basis a European Plan for Aviation Safety;


Whereas the Management Board has adopted in December 2022 the European Plan for Aviation Safety 2023-2025;

Whereas an update of the main safety risks and of the necessary actions to mitigate those risks has been provided by EASA;

Whereas the draft Volume II 'Action' has been consulted with the EASA Advisory Bodies;

Has decided to adopt the 2024 editions of EPAS Volume II 'Actions' and Volume III 'Safety Risk Portfolios', as set out in the annexed document.
