### Question:

**What EASA approved design changes are accepted by the UK CAA?**

### Answer:

The [Trade and Cooperation Agreement between UK and EU](#) states that non-significant supplemental type certificates, approvals of non-significant major changes, repairs and technical standard order authorisations issued by EASA or an EASA approved design organisation are accepted by the UK CAA without a need for issuance of an additional certificate. Further clarification on classification will be provided in the UK CAA/EASA TIP. Further details can be found in ANNEX 30 AIRWORTHINESS AND ENVIRONMENT CERTIFICATION, Article 13.
