**DECISION NO 2004/1/ADM OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY**

**of 23 January 2004**

**on the delegation of powers of the Executive Director to the Certification Director**

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN AVIATION SAFETY AGENCY

Having regard to the Regulation (EC) No 1592/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 July 2002 on common rules in the field of civil aviation and establishing a European Aviation Safety Agency<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter referred to as 'the Basic Regulation'), and in particular Articles 29(3)(e) and 29(3)(i) thereof,

Having regard to the measures of the European Aviation Safety Agency (hereinafter referred to as the 'Agency') as specified in Article 13 of the Basic Regulation,

**Whereas:**

- (1) The Executive Director is entitled in accordance with Article 29(3)(i) of the Basic Regulation to delegate his powers to other members of the Agency's staff according to rules adopted in accordance with the procedure referred to in Article 54(2) of the Basic Regulation; the Commission has adopted Decision of 23 January 2004 C (2004) 88 final on the rules governing delegation of the powers of the Executive Director of the European Aviation Safety Agency.
- (2) The Executive Director is entitled in accordance with Article 29(3)(e) of the Basic Regulation to take all necessary steps in order to ensure the functioning of the Agency.
- (3) The Management Board has appointed the Certification Director in accordance with Article 30 of the Basic Regulation and the Certification Director is part of the Agency's staff as defined in Article 20(3) of the Basic Regulation.

Article 1

The Executive Director delegates his powers to Mr Dr. Norbert Lohl, Certification Director of the Agency, to take decisions for the application of Articles 15 and 46 of the Basic Regulation, as specified in Article 13(c) of the Basic Regulation, in his field of activity, including:

- type certification and continued airworthiness of products, parts and appliances;
- environmental approval of products;
- design organisation approval and, as appropriate, production organisation approval;
- foreign organisation approval.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on 23 January 2004. It shall be published in the *Official Publication of the Agency*.
