EXPLANATORY NOTE

CS-25 Amendment 10

1. GENERAL

Executive Director Decision 2010/013/R amends Decision No 2003/02/RM of 17 October 2003 on certification specifications, including airworthiness codes and acceptable means of compliance for large aeroplanes (“CS-25”).

The Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA 2008-01) has been subject to consultation in accordance with Article 52(1)(c) of the Basic Regulation¹ and articles 5(3) and 6 of the Rulemaking Procedure established by the Management Board².

2. CRD REACTIONS

In response to the CRD 2008-01, the Agency received no substantive comments to CS-25.
