

FAQs:

Aircraft maintenance and continuing airworthiness — Restrictive measures Russia, EU restrictive measures against Russia

Question:

Is it allowed for a maintenance organisation approved by EASA under Part-145 to perform maintenance on components and provide such components to a non-EU, non-Russian operator, if this operator operates the aircraft to Russia?

Answer:

Yes, if this aircraft is not being used to fly domestically in Russia, or to otherwise circumvent the sanctions (NB Article 12 of <u>Regulation (EU) No 833/2014</u> prohibits any measures that would result in circumventing the sanctions).
