### Question:

Why do European rules require a list of specific approvals?

#### Answer:

Appendix V of the Authority Requirements (<u>Part-ARO</u>) contains a list of specific approvals for non-commercial operations and specialised operations. This list replicates in a proportionate manner the OpSpecs template for CAT operations.

The reasons for this list are to standardise the documentation of specific approvals for non-commercial operators and to support ramp inspectors in their oversight activities.
