1. GENERAL

Due to an editorial error, the consolidation version of CS-22 Amendment 2 in the Annex to the Executive Director Decision No 2009/004/R did not include the Amendment 1 update to CS-22. The paragraphs as stipulated under “CS-22 Amendment 1” on the Preamble page of the CS-22 Amendment 2, did not contain the changes introduced for cockpit crashworthiness. The corrected Amendment 2 to CS-22 is identified at each page by “Re-issued: CS-22 Amendment 2”.

Executive Director Decision 2009/009/R amends Decision No 2003/13/RM of 14 November 2003 (CS-22 Initial Issue). It represents Amendment 2 of CS-22: Sailplanes and powered sailplanes, and incorporates the output from the following EASA rulemaking task:
